Terms of Program

- ✓ Food for the program is donated from various sources; therefore, we cannot guarantee that food will be available or the quality of the food.
- ✓ You must have your membership card and bucket each time you pick up your food.
- ✓ The recipient will not be allowed to acquire more animals while participating in this program and will not be allowed to adopt from the FFDAS. Food will be provided for only 5 animals.
- ✓ The amount supplied will be at the discretion of the Friends For the Dearborn Animal Shelter.
- ✓ Because funds are limited, the program should only supplement the participants' monthly supply of pet food, and should not be the sole source of food for pets.
- ✓ Supply will only be distributed on one Saturday a month from 11:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. or while supplies last.
- ✓ Only residents of Wayne, Oakland, and Macomb Counties can apply for support. Excluding the cities of Plymouth and Canton.
- ✓ Upon withdrawal or termination from this program, participants are required to turn in their food buckets.
- ✓ All participants must agree to get their animal(s) sterilized as soon as possible, if they are not already.
- ✓ All participants must agree not to breed their animal(s) while receiving assistance through this program.
- ✓ It is to be understood that participants' membership in this program can be revoked at the discretion of the Friends For the Dearborn Animal Shelter.
- ✓ A home check may be required in order to process applications.
- ✓ All participants must sign a Save and Hold Harmless Agreement prior to receiving their first installment of supply.
