# FRIENDS FOR ANIMALS OF METRO DETROIT (FAMD) SEEKS INFORMATION ON GERMAN SHEPHERD WITH GUNSHOT WOUND

**DEARBORN, MI.** – Friends for Animals of Metro Detroit (FAMD) is seeking information about two German Shepherds received Wednesday, August 26.

This afternoon, FAMD received two German Shepherds, a male and a female, both estimated to be between 2 and 3 years old.

Both dogs were found together last night, August 25, on Michigan Ave. in Dearborn by a concerned citizen. The male, who the shelter has named Aragorn, was taken by the finder to Affiliated Veterinary Emergency Services for a badly injured right front leg. The vet determined the injury was from a recent gunshot wound, and also found that Aragorn has a fractured ulna. Treatment was begun for his injuries, and he will be seen on the shelter's vet run tomorrow to figure out the best course of treatment going further.

Both dogs are very sweet, and seem to be a bonded pair. The shelter has named the female Arwen, and it appears that she has had puppies in the past. Neither dog is microchipped or sterilized, and the male was found wearing a collar that was too tight.
