As Finance Director, she introduced budget/business planning processes and monthly operating reviews that improved planning, cost control and decision making for the staff and the board. Sophie also oversaw cash management for the operations and investments for the endowment established in 2010. Her efforts resulted in significant returns and a favorable cash position.

Sophie also supported the New Shelter Project. She was part of the team that developed the plan for the New Shelter and obtained the City's financial commitment. She developed and
