Tickets start at just \$100 to attend the virtual event, and guests will enjoy a 90-minute program broadcast live from the MaryAnn Wright Animal Adoption and Education Center. The program will be emceed by Fox2's Sports Director Dan Miller, and will feature adoptable animals, music by local musician Kevf, FAMD Mission Moments presented by professional stage actress Rebecka Reeve, presentation of the 2020 Big Heart Award, and online auctions.
