OUR ANIMALS

- Intake: 1,833 (562 dogs and 1,271 cats)
- Place rate overall: 84%
- Before adoption, all animals have age-appropriate vaccines, are spayed or neutered and microchipped

OUR CENTERS

MaryAnn Wright Animal Adoption and Education Center

- 10,000 square feet, utilizing best practices in animal sheltering
- Double compartment housing for all animals/separate areas for dogs and cats/natural light

NATIONAL STATISTICS*

- Estimated national annual spending on pets: \$95 billion
 - Households owning pets: 70%
 - Number of owned cats: 94 million
 - Number of owned dogs: 90 million
 - Shelter statistics for cats and dogs (annual):
 - » Intake: 907,451
 - » Intake of purebred dogs: 25%
 - For those who own pets, approximately 19% of dogs and 26% of cats are adopted from shelters

VOLUNTEERS

- 572 registered volunteers
- 17,225 hours donated (equivalent value of over \$491,601 in wages)
- 1,465 foster animals cared for with over 27,282 hours
- Student volunteers: One of the few sheltering organizations to accept youth under age 16
- Internships: Ongoing opportunities for local partnering schools, including University of Michigan-Dearborn

SUPPORTER DEMOGRAPHICS

- 44% of volunteers, 73% of donors, and 79% of adopters are from outside of Dearborn
- Shelter visitors: 1,682* people visited our shelter in 2021

PUBLIC RELATIONS

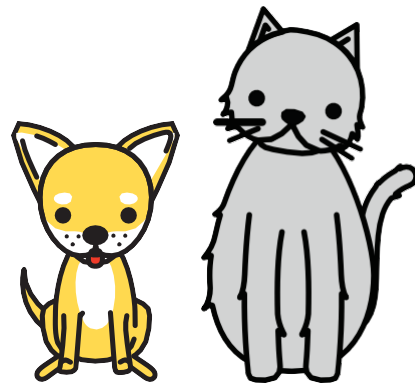
