Of the 253 dogs and cats that were humanely euthanized, $34 \%$ had serious behavior issues, such as aggression or extreme under socialization, $66 \%$ had serious medical issues or severe injuries.

*The Live Release rate does not include the 44 owner requested euthanasia or the 43 animals (injured, sick and neonates) that did not respond to medical intervention and died in the shelter/care. The Live Release Rate is calculated by dividing the 'Adjusted Live Intake Intake' + Beginning Population' into 'Total Number of Pets Saved'
