WITH ONLY TWO KENNEL SPACES LEFT, FRIENDS FOR ANIMALS OF METRO DETROIT IS AT CAPACITY AND RUNNING MARCH ADOPTION SPECIALS

DEARBORN March 15, 2024 – Help Friends for Animals of Metro Detroit get their population down by springing a pet out of the shelter! They have 54 dogs and 43 cats currently available for adoption, including nine long-term dogs that have all been at the shelter for over two months. Adult dogs, 20 lbs. and up, are \$50 and all cats are \$25. Adoption specials do not include \$10 microchip registration. The organization is looking for adopters to open their hearts to welcoming a new furry friend into their homes. Adopting an animal offers one animal the opportunity for a second chance in a new home and another animal the chance to find one!

The MaryAnn Wright Animal Adoption and Education Center is located at 16121 Reckinger Road in Dearborn and is open Tuesday – Sunday, 10 a.m. – Noon and 1 - 4 p.m. The Center is closed on Monday.

Last year, Friends for Animals reunited or found successful forever homes for over 2,500 animals; reuniting 202 lost pets with their owners; and through foster families, were able to give extra love and care to 707 dogs and cats.
