Of the 280 dogs and cats that were humanely euthanized, $33 \%$ had serious behavior issues, such as aggression or extreme under socialization, $67 \%$ had serious medical issues or severe injuries.

*The Live Release rate does not include the 77 owner requested euthanasia or the 56 animals (injured, sick and neonates) that did not respond to medical intervention and died or was lost in shelter/care. The Live Release Rate is calculated by dividing the 'Live Intake into 'Total Number of Pets Saved'
