FRIENDS FOR ANIMALS OF METRO DETROIT ANNOUNCES SECOND ANNUAL "PAWCHELLA" TWO-DAY FESTIVAL

Dearborn, MI. April 3, 2025 – Friends for Animals announces its second annual two-day animal festival, PAWCHELLA, presented by Village Ford, Saturday, June 7 – Sunday, June 8, from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. at the organization's MaryAnn Wright Animal Adoption and Education Center, located at 16121 Reckinger Road, Dearborn, MI 48126. This weekend-long fundraiser promises to be even bigger, and more engaging than last year's event.

The festival celebrates the joy of animals, community, and second chances. Hosted at the newly expanded MaryAnn Wright Animal Adoption & Education Center, the pledge-driven, fun-filled PAWCHELLA weekend is one of the many amazing ways Friends for Animals raises critical funds to help them care for the nearly 2,500 animals that come through the Dearborn shelter's doors each year.

This year's event marks a new era for Friends for Animals—with more activities, and a chance to explore the organization's fully finished facility.

In celebration of the seventh anniversary of the MaryAnn Wright Animal Adoption and Education Center, PAWCHELLA will kick off Saturday, June 7 with a dog pack walk at 9 a.m. to raise awareness and fundraise.

Saturday's bands include Sunglasses After Dark, HotRod D-Luxx, Urban Muse Band, and Martinez. Stick around for a fundraising corn hole tournament from 11 a.m. – 3 p.m. with 50% of the proceeds going back to Friends for Animals, tarot readings, and face painting. Both days will feature vendors, food, a bar, and a daily 50/50 raffle drawing. The Friends will also host an adopt-a-thon on both days, where rescues, foster-based rescues, shelters and other animal welfare organizations will come together to promote the mission behind the programming: Successfully uniting homeless pets with their new homes.

Sunday, June 8 will commence with yoga in the dog park with instructor Lily Trombly of Plymouth Yoga Room at 9 a.m. Plan for a tin can raffle, Magic with a Twist, and three more bands: Primary Soul, The Rockin' Boomers, and ConnQuest.

New this year are a dog dock diving exhibition, a fly ball exhibition, lure and agility courses for your own pup, and a passport for participants to collect stamps at four carnival games and "Find Fido" scavenger hunt stops to be entered for a chance to win prizes.

Enter the PAWCHELLA cash raffle for \$5 per ticket, sponsored by Premier Pet Supply, with six chances to win either a \$500 Premier Pet Supply gift card or the grand prize of \$2,500 cash! Drawing will be held at 2 p.m. June 8.
